

AUTO NUMBERING




DOCUMENTS CAN BE ADDED AND AUTO NUMBERED with this module through the Livelink® interface, Livelink Explorer®, or programmatically using LAPI.

ASSIGNING THE APPROPRIATE CATEGORY TO A FOLDER enables the document auto-numbering module. The Auto Numbering module contains an administration page where the specific category is defined.

THE AUTO NUMBERING CONFIGURATION PAGE also allows the user to identify which field will contain the auto-generated document number.

ONCE A FOLDER THAT WILL CONTAIN AUTO NUMBERING IS CREATED, documents can be added as needed and the Auto Numbering module will handle the document numbering. Go to the folder browse page to see the auto numbers displayed. To disable document numbering for a document or folder, simply remove the selected Category.
